The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 166 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
9/13	Whitehaven Rd.	Youth Activity	The complainant states that several youths appeared to be throwing rocks at vehicles in River Oaks Marina during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the youths and determined they were throwing water balloons. No damage was reported.
9/13	Love Rd.	Loud Music	The complainant states that loud music was coming from Say Cheese Pizza during the late hours of the night. Deputies advised employees on location and the music was turned down.
9/13	Grand Island Blvd.	Customer Trouble	Employees of Monroe Muffler state that a customer was on location and was causing a disturbance in the store. Deputies advised the subject who then left without incident.
9/13	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a phone company box on the side of the road was open and no one was nearby. Deputies determined the incident to be an oversight as it appeared recent maintenance had been conducted.
9/13	Park La.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked near the dead end and the subjects inside went into the wooded area during the late evening hours. Deputies located the subjects and advised them. The subjects left without incident.
9/13	Marilyn Dr.	Youth Activity	The complainant states that several youths were in the neighborhood ringing doorbells and then running away. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the youths.
9/14	Baseline Rd.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle was swerving all over the road and then appeared to pick up a subject on walking on the side of the road. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.

9/14	South State Pkwy.	Drunk	The complainant, who was driving by, saw a male subject fall off his bicycle. Deputies located the subject, who was intoxicated, and assisted him by contacting a family member to come pick him up.
9/14	Love Rd.	Deer Struck	Deputies responded to a report of a 1 car motor vehicle accident involving a deer. No injuries were reported.
9/14	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states a subject who was possibly intoxicated got into a pickup truck and drove away. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle by the description given.
9/15	Alvin Rd.	Larceny	Employees of Fucillo Chevrolet state that sometime in recent days, an unknown person(s) stole several inspection stickers from the business.
9/15	Colonial Dr. West	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that her car alarm went off during the late evening hours. The complainant then heard another car alarm activate somewhere in the area. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate any persons.
9/16	Colonial Dr. West	Loud Music	The complainant states that a radio was playing loudly during the late hours of the night. Deputies spoke with the occupants and advised them.
9/16	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject was sleeping on the ground in the Key Bank parking lot. Deputies located the subject who was trying to stay out of the rain.
9/16	Grand Island Blvd.	Criminal Mischief	Employees of Tai Pei Restaurant state that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) egged the building and wrote on it with magic marker.
9/16	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a male subject was sleeping on the lawn of the Grand Island Town Hall. Deputies located the subject and advised him. The subject left without incident.
9/17	Whitehaven Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
9/17	Sunset Dr.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked near the end of the street and believed the owner may be a hunter. Deputies located the subject and advised him.
9/18	West River Rd.	Neighbor Dispute	Deputies responded to a report of a neighbor dispute. The subjects had a disagreement over the property line and were advised.
9/18	Wallace Dr.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a subject was inside of a vacant house during the evening hours. Deputies located the subject and determined he was conducting maintenance on the residence.
9/19	Huth Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
9/19	Garden Pk.	Illegal Dumping	The complainant states that a subject in a pickup truck was dumping rubbish at the dead end of the street. Deputies located the subject who was disposing of tree trimmings. The subject removed the trimmings and left without incident.
9/19	Cardinal La.	Larceny	The complainant states that at an unknown time, an unknown person(s) stole a ladder from his garage and some firewood from his back step.

9/19	Grand Island Blvd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call at Tops. Deputies checked the premise but were unable to locate any person in need of police assistance.
9/19	East River Rd.	Hunters	The complainant states that he heard what appeared to be an airsoft pistol discharge in the area while he was walking his dog. Deputies checked the area but were unable to hear any more shots.
