Date	Type	Street	Narrative
8/22/2026	Fire Residential	Ferry Rd.	Patrol arrived at a home on the listed street to find smoke coming from the corner of the garage and the only occupant already outside. Patrol unsuccessfully attempted to extinguish the fire with fire extinguishers. Grand Island Fire then arrived and took over efforts to knock down the flames. The Fire Investigation Unit responded for the investigation.
8/24/2026	Suspicious Incident	Baseline Rd.	Patrol responded to a report of a female subject searching through bags on the ground. The subject had an active warrant out of Niagara County. The 61-year-old Grand Island woman was taken into custody and turned over to Lewiston police.
8/24/2026	Assist Person	Whitehaven Rd.	A resident came to the Grand Island substation to pick up his son's bike, which was found on 8/23 near the intersection of W. River Rd. and Fix Rd.
8/25/2026	Accident – Injury	Bedell Rd.	Two vehicles traveling in opposite directions on the listed street collided when one of the vehicles attempted a left-hand turn. Twin City Ambulance transported three victims to three different hospitals (ECMC, Kenmore Mercy, Golisano Children's) for treatment.
8/27/2026	Motorist Broke Down	Bedell Rd. at Grand Island Blvd.	Patrol assisted with traffic control after an NFTA bus broke down in the intersection.
8/27/2026	Accident – PDO	Grand Island Blvd.	Patrol investigated a property damage only accident. It was determined a vehicle rear-ended a second vehicle, causing damage.
