The Erie County Sheriff's Office responded to 147 calls the week of this report. Below is a sampling of the noteworthy incidents on **Grand Island**.

Date	Street	Type	Narrative
8/24	Whitehaven Rd.	Suspicious Person with Vehicle	The complainant states a vehicle was on the side of the road with its 4 way flashers on and the driver appeared to be lost. Deputies located the vehicle and advised the driver.
8/24	Woodstock Dr.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call. Deputies spoke to the occupants of the residence and determined the call to be a misdial.
8/24	Love Rd.	Fight	The complainant states she heard what appeared to be a fight occurring in the parking lot of Say Cheese Pizza. Deputies spoke to numerous individuals on scene all who denied any knowledge of a fight.
8/24	Love Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked on the lawn of a neighboring residence and was unsure if anyone was inside. Deputies determined the vehicle to belong to a family member of the residence in question.
8/24	Grand Island Blvd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) removed a political campaign sign from his lawn. The sign did not sustain any damage and was reassembled by the complainant.
8/24	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	The complainant states that while he was at Fantasy Island an unknown person(s) stole a wallet from his pocket. After further investigation it was determined the items were left in the complainant's vehicle and had not been stolen.
8/24	East River Rd.	Fireworks Use	The complainant states that fireworks were being used at a residence in the area of Warner Dr. Deputies checked the area but did not observe any fireworks.
8/24	Grand Island Blvd.	Loud Music	The complainant states that loud music was coming from a local establishment. Deputies checked and determined the music was not violating any noise ordinance.
8/25	Ward Park Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that she found narcotic paraphernalia in her backyard and wanted to turn it over to Patrol. Deputies seized the items and disposed of them.
8/25	Driftwood Dr.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime during the night,

			an unknown person(s) stole 2 bicycles from his yard.
8/25	Bedell Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states that sometime in recent days, an unknown person(s) entered the fenced in Miracle League Baseball Field and caused minor damage by rollerblading on it.
8/25	East River Rd.	Criminal Mischief	The complainant states at an unknown time, an unknown person(s) damaged the windshield to his vehicle.
8/25	Grand Island Blvd.	Larceny	The complainant states that while he was at Fantasy Island, an unknown person(s) broke into his vehicle and stole various items from inside. The suspect(s) gained entry by damaging the lock to the vehicle door.
8/25	Grand Island Blvd.	Disorderly Person	Employees of Fantasy Island state that a female patron of the park was causing a disturbance. Deputies advised the female who left the premise without further incident.
8/25	Lakeview Te.	Loud Music	The complainant states that a loud party was outside of his apartment building. Deputies checked and determined the complaint to be unfounded.
8/26	White Tail Run	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call. Deputies spoke to the occupants and determined the call to be a mistake.
8/26	Pin Oak Cr.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a female subject was walking up and down the street in the rain and talking to herself. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the subject.
8/26	Love Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a vehicle damaged her mailbox and lawn and left behind the license plate. Deputies contacted the driver of the vehicle who returned to the scene and agreed to pay for the damages.
8/26	Baseline Rd.	Pistol Permit Investigation	Deputies conducted a background check of an individual who applied for a pistol permit.
8/27	Baseline Rd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
8/27	Carl Rd.	Motorist Broke Down	Deputies assisted a motorist whose vehicle had become disabled.
8/27	Grand Island Blvd.	Welfare Check	Deputies responded to a report of a 911 hang up call from a local business. Deputies spoke to the employees and determined the call to be a misdial.
8/27	West River Pkwy.	Reckless Operation	The complainant states that a vehicle was driving all over the roadway. Deputies checked the area but were unable to locate the vehicle.
8/27	West River Rd.	Residential Burglary	The complainant states that sometime during the day, an unknown person(s) broke into his residence by prying open a door and stole various items while inside. Investigation Ongoing.
8/28	Grand Island Blvd.	Accident PDO	Deputies responded to a report of a 2 car motor vehicle accident. No injuries were reported.
8/28	Bedell Rd.	Residential Burglary	Deputies responded to a burglary alarm at a residence on Bedell Rd. and found an unlocked door. Deputies searched the residence but found no persons inside. A further check with the homeowner confirmed that an unknown person(s) had entered the residence and moved numerous items but nothing was reported missing. Investigation Ongoing.

8/28	Stony Point Rd.	Larceny	The complainant states that sometime in recent weeks an unknown person(s) had stolen various items from his vehicle. Investigation Ongoing.
8/28	Schwegler Rd.	Suspicious Incident	The complainant states that a screen window to a nearby residence was lying on the ground. Deputies checked the residence and did not observe any damage.
8/28	Brandywine Dr.	Animal Loose	The complainant states she found a cockatiel bird in her yard.
8/28	Baseline Rd.	Suspicious Person	The complainant states that a suspicious male subject was in the roadway and appeared to be wearing a mask during the late hours of the night. Deputies located the male who stated that he was attempting to remove a sweatshirt and became tangled in the garment.
8/29	Carter Dr.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked on the street in front of his residence during the late hours of the night and appeared to be occupied by several subjects. Deputies located the vehicle and advised the occupants who stated they were talking about relationship issues.
8/29	Enola Rd.	Loud Music	The complainant states that loud music was coming from a nearby residence during the late hours of the night. Prior to the arrival of Patrol, the complainant called back and stated the music was off and no longer required police assistance.
8/30	Bedell Rd.	Burglary	The complainant states that sometime during the night, an unknown person(s) broke into his business and stole a small sum of money. Investigation Ongoing.
8/30	Stony Point Rd.	Found Property	The complainant states that she found a bicycle in the ditch on the property in front of her residence. Deputies took custody of the bicycle.
8/30	Huth Rd.	Suspicious Vehicle	The complainant states that a vehicle was parked in front of his residence with its headlights on for approximately 1 hour. Deputies located the vehicle and advised the driver who stated he had pulled over to make a phone call.
