

LOCAL EMERGENCY ORDER - TOWN OF GRAND ISLAND

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, April 15, 2020, May 15, 2020, and June 15, 2020, I issued a Proclamation of a Local State of Emergency pursuant to Section 24(1) of Article 2-B of the Executive Law as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic; the current Local State of Emergency is in effect to and including July 15, 2020 and the Governor has declared a State Disaster Emergency, which is currently in effect; and

WHEREAS, Governor Cuomo has announced that public pools may be opened according to the discretion of local governments and the Town of Grand Island has determined to permit the opening of public pools; and

WHEREAS, to ensure compliance with the New York State Department of Health's guidance for public pools, the Town's approval for such opening is contingent upon strict compliance with the applicable State Department of Health Guidance;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, John C. Whitney, Town Supervisor of the Town of Grand Island, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Laws of the State of New York, hereby issue the following Local Emergency Order pursuant to Section 24 of the Executive Law:

(1) Pursuant to Governor Cuomo's directive, the Town of Grand Island has determined that public and private pools may open, provided, however, that guidance from the New York State Department of Health, issued on June 11, 2020 and as may be amended or supplemented, is followed.
