WHEREAS, the NYS Environmental Facilities Corporation (EFC) authorizes State assistance to municipalities for clean water quality improvement projects by means of a contract, and the Town of Grand Island deems it to be in the public interest and benefit under this law to enter into a contract therewith.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Grand Island Town Board, that:

Supervisor Nathan McMurray, or his representative or successor in office, is the representative authorized to act on behalf of the Grand Island Town Board in all matters related to State assistance under the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation (EFC) and/or any applicable State grant provisions.

The Supervisor, or his representative, is also authorized to make an application in the amount of \$2,703,075 which the Town is requesting 25% of the total project cost in grant funding, list the Project in the CWSRF Intended Use Plan (IUP), submit Project documentation, and otherwise act on behalf of the Grand Island Town Board in all matters related to the Project and to State assistance;

The Town of Grand Island Town Board agrees to fund its portion of the cost of the Project, not to exceed 75% of the total project cost by way of a General Obligation Bond or a series of Bond Anticipation Notes financed over a period of five or more years as well as a contribution from the Town's capital reserves account, and that funds will be made available to initiate the Project efforts within 12 months of written approval of its application by the NYS Department of Health and the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation authority;

That one certified copy of this Resolution be prepared and sent to the Albany office of the NYS Environmental Facilities Corporation; and

This Resolution takes effect immediately.
