Specialized baseball diamond will be accessible to disabled

About a dozen people—including organizers, Sabres alumni, elected officials and the disabled—will man shovels at 2 p. m. today for the groundbreaking for the Sabres Miracle League Field complex on Grand Island.

The field, set to open late this summer in Grand Island's Veterans Park, will include a baseball diamond topped by a special two-inch rubberized, seamless surface, so that the disabled will be able to play ball on a more even playing surface.

The Miracle League of Grand Island & Western New York also will hold a "BBQ and Beer" fundraiser, from 2 to 7 p. m. May 7 at the Grand Island Rod and Gun Club on Whitehaven Road. Former Sabres star Rene Robert will be the auctioneer. Donations are \$20 per person.
