

Woman pleads not guilty to sale, possession of drugs

LOCKPORT—A Grand Island woman pleaded not guilty Tuesday in State Supreme Court to sale and possession of both heroin and methadone.

Danielle L. Kotas, 29, of Carter Drive, was arraigned before Justice Richard C. Kloch Sr. after being indicted on charges of third-degree sale and criminal possession of a controlled substance and fourth-degree sale and fifth-degree criminal possession of a controlled substance. She is free on \$5,000 bond.

Kotas allegedly sold methadone and heroin to a confidential informant in North Tonawanda on Jan. 13 and 14. She was arrested in April.
