

Drugged driving charged after crash on Island

A Grand Island man was charged with drugged driving Monday afternoon after a crash in the town.

Erie County Deputies Ryan Rogers and Matthew Cipollitti responded to a crash on Grand Island Boulevard shortly before 3 p.m. and found that Adam Flint, 24, had backed into another vehicle, causing minor damage, according to sheriff's officials.

The deputies said Flint admitted that he took narcotics before the crash and that he was driving without a license because of various alcohol-related offenses.

Flint was charged with driving while under the influence of drugs, felony aggravated unlicensed operation of a motor vehicle, seventh-degree criminal possession of a controlled substance and traffic infractions.
