

# **Graffiti in men's bathroom leads to arrest on Island**

Graffiti found in the men's bathroom of a Tim Hortons bakery and cafe led to the arrest Sunday of a 19-year old Grand Island man.

Erie County sheriff's deputies responded to the restaurant on Grand Island Boulevard after getting a report that teenagers in the store early Sunday had left a large amount of graffiti in the bathroom.

Deputies found the teenagers and learned that one of them was responsible for the graffiti.

The man's name was withheld because the Sheriff's Office has a policy against releasing names in instances where the arrested person may qualify for youthful offender status.

He was charged with third-degree criminal mischief, a felony, as well as making graffiti and possession of a graffiti instrument—both misdemeanors. He was arraigned in Grand Island Town Court and taken to the Erie County Holding Center on \$2,500 cash bail.
