Items which can be brought to the site for free, proper disposal include:

- ♦ PESTICIDES, FERTILIZERS, POOL AND HOUSEHOLD CHEMICALS/CLEANERS -limit 2 gallons or 20#
- ♦ OIL-BASED PAINTS, SPRAY CANS -limit 10 gallons
- ♦ PAINT THINNER, STRIPPER & SOLVENTS -limit 2 gallons
- ♦ BATTERIES - lead acid & rechargeable
- ♦ OIL, GASOLINE, KEROSENE, ANTIFREEZE-limit 10 gallons
- ♦ MERCURY - thermometers, thermostats, metal
- ♦ PROPANE TANKS & CYLINDERS - full or empty
- ♦ TIRES—REMOVE THE RIMS
- ♦ ELECTRONIC WASTE -computers, printers, scanners

Items that will not be accepted:

- ♦ LATEX PAINT— DRY OUT IN CANS AND PUT IN REGULAR GARBAGE
- ♦ PHARMACEUTICAL WASTE
- ♦ COMMERCIAL INDUSTRIAL WASTE
- ♦ WHITE GOODS (WASHERS/ DRYERS, STOVES)
- ♦ YARD WASTE
- ♦ HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE
- ♦ HOUSEHOLD RECYCLABLES

Note: Participants may need to verify that wastes are generated by households.
