Alt Farm - 2489 Whitehaven Road

Farmstead from one of the founding families of Grand Island – featuring the original farmhouse and barn built in the late 1800s, an icehouse, and Grand Island Schoolhouse #8 recently renovated into the Alt Nature Center.



River Lea - Beaver Island State Park

Built in 1873 as part of the Lewis F. Allen estate, the current home to the Grand Island Historical Society contains memorabilia from U.S. President Grover Cleveland (who worked on his uncle's farm as a young man) as well as Victorian furnishings.
