3. Any other mark or writing, or any erasure made on this ballot outside the voting ovals or blank spaces provided for write-in may void this entire ballot.
4. To vote for a person whose name is not imprinted on this ballot, write the name and fill in the oval in the blank space which appears at the bottom of the column under the title of the office.

5. Do not overvote. If you select a greater number of candidates than the number of offices to be filled, your ballot will be void for that public office or party position.
6. If you tear, deface, or wrongly mark this ballot, return ballot by making erasures or cross outs. Erasures or submitting your ballot, if you make a mistake in completing and return a new ballot. You have the right to obtain and complete a new ballot.
