## Fight ends in stabbing on Grand Island

GRAND ISLAND, N.Y. (WIVB) - An early-morning fight ends with a stabbing on Grand Island.

Officials at the Erie County Sheriff's Sub Station are trying to figure out if a broken golf club could have been used to stab a young man at 2:30 a.m. Thursday, on Carl Road.

Officials say Carl Road turned from a peaceful to a violent scene when about six people confronted each other. They exchanged words and according to officials they began fighting. In the end, one male victim was stabbed and many others were left with minor injuries.

"Approximately six people fighting in the street, it was an altercation involving two different groups. One vehicle driving down here, words were exchanged, altercation started, multiple people fighting. There was a golf club involved, we don't know fully to what extent that played in the incident but we know that there was one involved," said Erie County Sheriff's Office Lt. Bill Cranston.

The male victim was transported to ECMC, his name and condition have not been released.

Investigators on the scene found two golf clubs. One was broken in half, and they said they're trying to figure out if that could have been used to stab the victim.

Three people are being detained by the Sheriff's Office. News 4 will bring you the latest information on the stabbing, as it becomes available.
