Two men arrested for stealing televisions

Two men accused of stealing TVs at Grand Island motel Two men were arrested early Sunday on charges of stealing television sets from a pair of rooms at the Chateau Motel on Grand Island, the Erie County Sheriff's Office reported.

Deputies responded at about 3:30 a.m. to a complaint from the owner of the Grand Island Boulevard hotel that two people had stolen TVs from a pair of rooms and driven off in the same vehicle.

Deputies Bradley Girdler and Jason Clark spotted the vehicle in question a short time later, pulled it over and found the stolen property inside.

They charged Jacques P. Pigeon, 20, of Grand Island, and Robert N. Giovino, 20, of Cheektowaga, with burglary, petit larceny, criminal possession of stolen property and criminal possession of burglary tools.

Earlier versions of this story mistakenly listed Giovino's father as one of the two people arrested. That mistaken identification was based on incorrect information from the sheriff's initial news release.
