We THANK the diehard residents that continue to cut both sides of the Parkway to enhance the West River portion of the Island. A word of thanks is no-where near the appreciation the residents deserve. By cutting the parkway, it also contributes to the SAFETY for commuters so they can travel & cross roads SAFELY without the overgrown grass and invasive weed species that block view of traffic and harbor ticks which can transmit Lyme Disease

Parkway Concept: Perception or Persuasion

Rewind back when the West River Parkway was introduced and implemented for vehicle traffic. According to the residents it was in favor and agreed to. It seemed to be maintained on a regular seasonal basis.

The present: The slow recent decline in maintaining the Parkway green space: one might ask: Why have they not kept their end of the bargain, and refuse to regularly maintain it seasonally? What is the parkway like today? Although not cut & trimmed by the state, the Parkway road portion is still travelled by many commuters and visitors, and is still in decent condition in comparison to other State &

The future: Closing the Parkway to repurpose it for a pedestrian trail: The "artist rendering" may look nice to the eye, but don't let the "art" fool you, thinking that it will always "look" like the rendering forever. It is only a perception to persuade the public. One must remember that not necessarily will the rendering imply a lifelong maintained parkway.

Our 3 Town Counsel Board members have been working hard to keep the parkway from closing. Councilman Mike Madigan has put in exceptional efforts by attending many meetings and sending letters to NY State officials voicing on behalf of the people of Grand Island and West River Residents.

Grand Island Residents are IN FAVOR of a multi-use trail, as originally proposed and funded. We are NOT IN FAVOR of parkway closure.
