APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURES:

- 1. Scholarship recipients are selected by the Veronica Connor Scholarship Committee of The Zonta Club of Grand Island.
- 2. Applications are evaluated on the basis of scholastic ability, participation in academic programs, and extra-curricular activities.
- 3. Two recommendations are required: one from a school-related official and the other from someone who knows you personally. Each reference should be furnished with one of the attached Recommendation Forms.
- 4. The candidate must complete the attached Application Form.
- 5. Contact your school's counseling department and present the attached *Consent to Release Educational Records* form to your counselor.
- 6. Financial need will be given consideration in the selection process but will not be the essential factor.
- 7. All application materials, including the application form, release of records, essay and letters of recommendation must be submitted to **The Zonta Club of Grand Island**, **Scholarship Committee**, **PO Box 1104**, **Grand Island**, **NY 14072 by May 15**, 2010.
